Massachusetts Pensions And Income Taxes in Other States

JANUARY 2009 – When considering a move outside the Commonwealth, there are naturally several factors a member weighs before making a decision. Among them is whether their contributory pension, which is not subject to tax here, will be taxed by the prospective new homes state.

Currently Fifteen states do not tax Massachusetts Pensions. They are listed in the chart below.

In addition, several states provide tax exemptions or exclusions, for which Massachusetts pension may qualify. For example, Maine offers a pension exemption, while pensioners, 59 ½ or over, may qualify for an exemption in New York.

Unfortunately, there are states that tax Massachusetts pension in full. Connecticut, Rhode Island and Vermont are included in that group.

Since such a disparity exists among the states and tax laws may contain details which could disqualify a retiree, it's strongly suggested you check with the tax official in the particular state to which you are interested in moving.

How the Other Forty Nine State Tax Massachusetts Pensions.
